Multiple sclerosis, or MS for short, is also known as 'the disease with a thousand faces': no two cases are alike. The functional impairments caused by MS through inflammation in the nervous system can vary greatly in severity and progression.

Sensory disturbances, numbness or tingling in the arms, legs and torso restrict movement in everyday life. Eating with a spoon becomes a challenge – particularly when combined with the visual disturbances typical of MS, which impair contrast sensitivity and visual acuity.

With its hidden features, ORNAMIN tableware helps people with MS to maintain enjoyment and a zest for life at the dining table: Also, the coloured rim of the tableware provides better orientation thanks to the clear contrast with the white interior of the plate and the dining table.

The plates, bowls, cups and trays are designed to be intuitive for all. The hidden features provide additional support in tackling everyday challenges. In this way, ORNAMIN tableware promotes and maintains independence when eating and drinking.

The key to maintaining independence is active engagement: coordination and movement difficulties can only be addressed through constant practice.

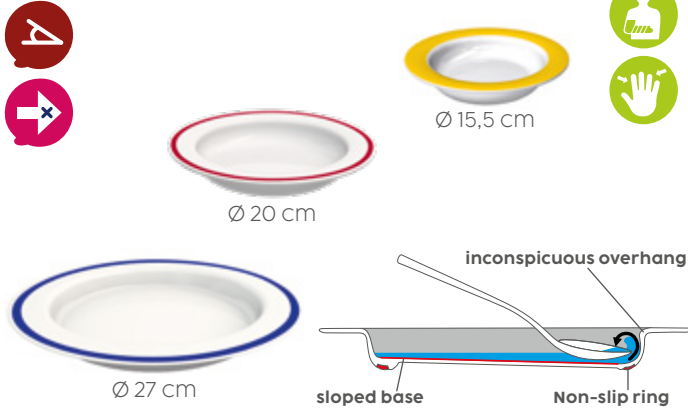

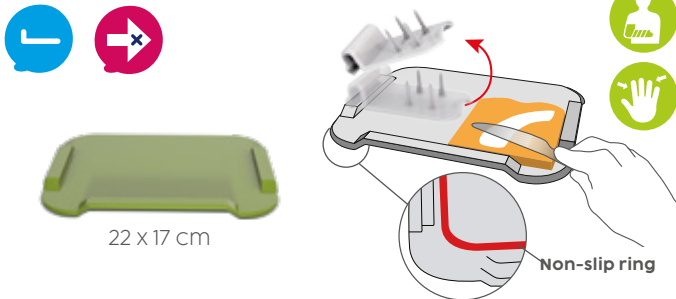
PLATE AND BOWL WITH SLOPED BASE
